Farm Credit Midsouth Refunds \$4 Million

Jonesboro, AR -- The Board of Directors of Farm Credit Midsouth, ACA has approved the distribution of almost \$4 million in patronage earnings to eligible stockholders.

The patronage checks will be distributed at Farm Credit Midsouth's annual meeting on February 26 at the Arkansas State University Convocation Center. Since 2005 the Board has approved and distributed almost \$16 million in patronage earnings to its stockholders/borrowers.

"Given the current instability of many financial institutions, we are proud to not only say we are sound but to show it with our patronage," says Gary Sitzer, chairman of the board.

"Part of our vision is to have a strong capital position and maintain our locally controlled cooperative nature," adds CEO Gary Kinder. "Agriculture is the foundation of our territory and we are fortunate to be an active part of that industry."

Farm Credit Midsouth, ACA, (a part of the Farm Credit System) is a federally-chartered cooperative providing credit and related services to agriculture producers and rural home owners in 10 Eastern Arkansas counties (Clay, Greene, Craighead, Mississippi, Crittenden, Poinsett, Cross, St. Francis, Lee and Phillips) and 3 counties in Missouri (Ripley, Carter and Wayne) through its wholly-owned PCA and FLCA subsidiaries.
